

Hazardous and Environmental Response Services IDIQ | *Various Locations throughout the U.S. | BLM*

Emergency response and other environmental response services involving hazardous materials, which are regulated by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), or State regulatory agencies; providing the BLM with technical assistance including examination and verification of sites on BLM-managed lands, where a hazardous material release has occurred or is suspected; removal, remedial, corrective, and disposal actions associated with a site where a hazardous material release is identified or suspected; and assistance with pollution prevention, waste minimization, hazardous materials inventory and waste stream management and disposal

FBI Chicago Erosion Control | *Illinois | \$5.1M | FBI Facilities and Acquisitions Unit*

Construction and stabilization of the hill facing Michigan Lake; includes various activities such as open trenching, directional drilling, drainage improvements, stormwater system replacement, and installation of a new sewer system; stabilize the top of the slope, a sheet pile retaining wall would be anchored, and armor stone would be placed at the foot of the slope; the sheet pile wall would be driven to a depth of 25 to 30 feet, and a security fence would be installed on top of it

Yuma 6 Morelos Dam Gaps 1 & 2 | *Yuma, Arizona | \$9.9M | DHS-Customs & Border Protection*

Design and construction services for the closure of Gaps 1 & 2 within the Yuma 6 project limits; Gap 1 is approximately 320-ft wide and is to be closed off using mesh style and bollard style fence and mesh style sliding gate; Gap 2 is approximately 1,350-ft wide and is closed off using mesh style floating fence

Alaska Petroleum, Oil, and Lubricants (POL) MATOC | *Various Locations Alaska & USPACOM | USACE Alaska District*

IDIQ contract for the DB/DBB of minor new construction, maintenance, repair, upgrade, or alteration of existing POL storage facilities, distribution systems, and POL support facilities. Renovations include fuel containment, transport, delivery, storage, and dispensing systems as well as conversion of fuel type. Incidental services include design and inspections such as API 653 tank inspection, piping system evaluation in accordance with API 570, pipe stress analysis, hydraulic and dynamic transient surge analysis, pressure testing, and internal pipeline inspection services

FTW459 Repair Barracks B3207 | *Fort Wainwright, Alaska | \$12.1M | USACE Alaska District*

Design-build to correct building deficiencies from normal wear and tear, update the heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) direct digital controls (DDCs) and resolve current mechanical system operational issues. Provide new ceiling tile and flooring throughout the building; patch and paint all walls; install new DDC controls and replace control valves in all 144 dorm rooms; install light emitting diode (LED) lighting and ceiling fans in all 144 dorm rooms; replace, repair/paint all exterior doors; repair exterior insulation finishing systems (EIFS); install a redesigned downspout; repair two sewage lift stations; repair main mechanical room from recent water damage; add new additional washer and drier connections to the existing laundry room; and convert four multipurpose rooms to weight rooms
