As a subsidiary of Chenega Corporation – an Alaska Native Corporation, we can accept direct awards up to \$100M from Department of Defense (DoD), NASA, and US Coast Guard (USCG); and direct awards up to \$25M from other agencies without requiring Justification and Approval (J&A).

PROCUREMENT STRATEGY

Chenega has continually provided exceptional technical value and innovative direct cost saving solutions to its US Government customers. To ensure the highest quality of services at the lowest price, Chenega recommends that our customers determine best value using trade-off source selection criteria/methodology. We recommend further that the customer place value on measurable performance objectives and standards, higher quality or performance, technical approaches, and innovations and future technological advantages.

OUR APPROACH

Chenega recommends that the customer continue to draw on the resources and success of the SBA 8(a) Business Development Program to fulfill their security services requirement. This can be accomplished through an 8(a) competitive procurement or through 8(a) sole source procurement, which Chenega is eligible to receive.

As an ANC owned entity, Chenega offers a unique, flexible, and streamlined sole source procurement option. Available through all SBA-certified 8(a) subsidiaries within the Chenega family of companies, sole source contracting with Chenega provides the Government with Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) and Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) provisioned methods to maximize performance flexibility, mission continuity, and small business goal achievement.

KEY SOLE SOURCE ADVANTAGES

- A significantly accelerated procurement timeline, without the disruptions and delays resulting from complex evaluations and resulting protests
- Subcontracts awarded to an ANC or Indian tribe shall be counted towards the subcontracting goals for small business and small disadvantaged business (SDB) concerns, regardless of the size or SBA certification status of the ANC or Indian tribe. FAR 19.703 (c)(1)(i)
- Flexibility and reliability through direct negotiations per 13 CFR 124.503, competitive threshold exemptions per 48 CFR 19.805-1, and common administrative services between all Chenega subsidiaries
- Elimination of pre-award schedule risk due to the non-protestable nature of ANC sole source procurements per 13 CFR 124.517
- ANCs – unlike other 8(a) companies – provide the Government with a virtually unlimited sole source ceiling per 48 CFR 6.303-1

WHY AN ALASKA NATIVE CORPORATION?

The Government may award sole source contracts to ANC 8(a) companies up to \$100M without Justification and Approval (J&A) and more than \$100M with J&A, offering an unlimited threshold. The ceiling for sole source contract awards to a non-ANC 8(a) company is limited to \$4M for non-manufacturing and \$6.5M for manufacturing contracts.

ACCELERATED PROCUREMENT TIMELINE

Measured in weeks rather than months, a sole source procurement provides the benefit of Chenega's high-quality and CPARS-demonstrated performance approximately six times faster than a standard procurement. With open discussions across the procurement process immediately following SBA approval, we offer the ability and expertise to help tailor pre-award requirements for our customers to best achieve their desired post-award outcomes.
